Increased the number of traders at the weekly market and expanded the goods and produce on offer.

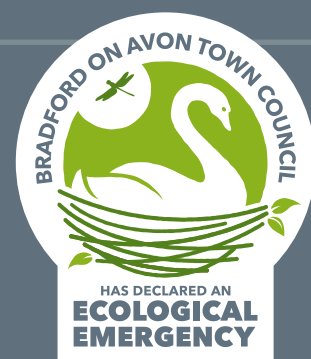
If you would like rewilding and where you would like to see it.

What you think of our newsletter and BoA Snippets.

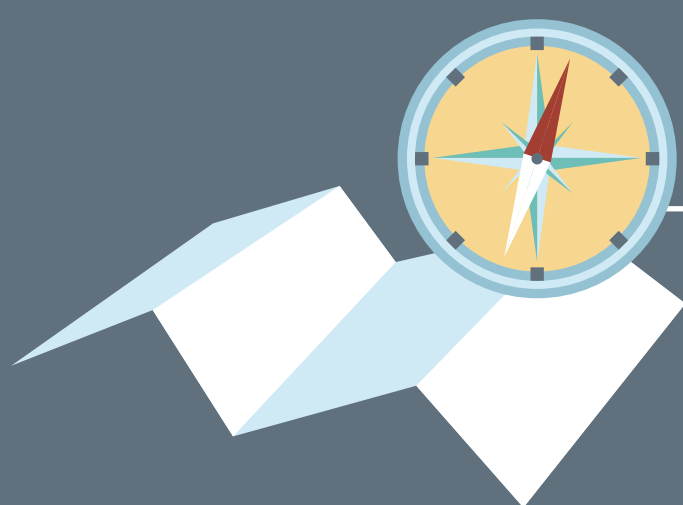
### WHAT YOU SAID

- make BoA Snippets snappier.

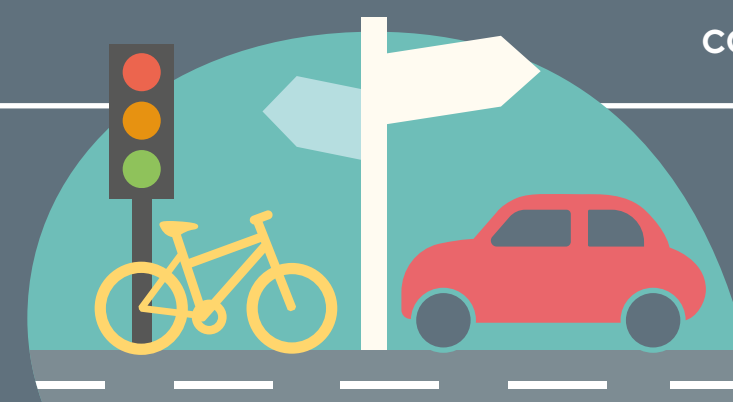
### WHAT WE DID

You told us how your children or young family played and identified play areas in other towns/ cities you enjoyed.

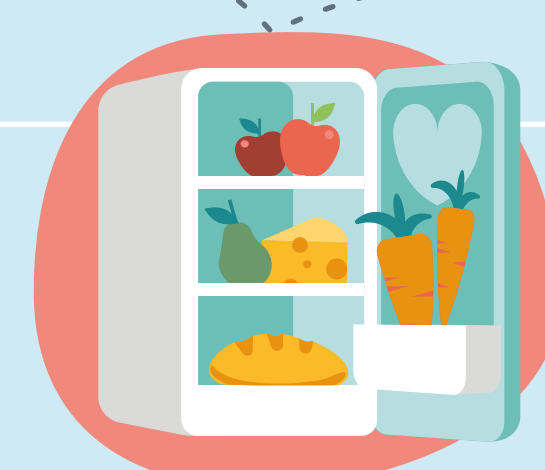
### WHAT WE DID
