19. Financial Regulations

A site visit was made to St. Margaret's hall car park to discuss possible siting places for the fridge, which would be easily assessible to all. An area by the ticket machine adjacent to the public toilets was considered, which would need conservation area approval and permission from Wiltshire Council, as owners of the car park.
