Recommendation

Berryfield House is a Grade II listed building with a requirement that the building <u>and its</u> <u>setting</u> needs to be protected. On that basis the application is inadequate in that it does not show where the garden room is to be located or how it visually relates to the main house. The proposal is a timber clad flat roof prefabricated structure which clearly has not been designed for its location but appears to have been selected from a catalogue of off-the-peg designs.

This application is inadequate to accurately describe how the proposal affects the historic house and consequently the impact of the proposal cannot be assessed.

Additional information is needed to comply with the requirement of S66(1) of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 "that in considering whether to grant permission for development which affects a listed building or its setting, the local planning authority shall have special regard to the desirability of preserving the building or its setting or any features of special architectural or historic interest which it possesses. As a consequence, the desirability of preservation must be given considerable importance and weight in the decision making process".

Without this assessment, or if the assessment shows the proposal is damaging to the setting of the listed building the application should be **Refused**.
