The Town Council considers that the bike store and Shepard's hut are by their design and choice of materials incongruous in the locality and damaging to the environment of neighbours, a number of whom have lodged objections.

The remedial work suggested including additional planting will not hide the structure or minimise its impact and the 1.8m high close boarded fencing indicated on plan 05 will be a further intrusion.
