REFUSE

The loss of commercial space is contrary to policy and no evidence has been submitted to demonstrate that the space cannot be used for its current purpose. There is also no evidence that the area retained as a retail unit is commercially viable with the reduced space. The access to the residential unit is via the Bullpit where there is a significant flood risk such that safe access at all times cannot be guaranteed.

RECOMMEND

The Town council notes with concern that Permitted Development rights were not withdrawn to protect the much needed parking provision on this site and would request that as far as possible sufficient the space in the garage is retained to accommodate a family car. With regards to proposed new windows any consent should be subject to a condition that the details and finishes should be exact copies of the existing windows to maintain the architectural harmony of the development.

19/06969/FUL - Canal Farm Trowbridge Rd BA15 1UA

The Town Council notes that this proposal is outside the Settlement Boundary and is on the Green Belt. Accordingly, Wiltshire Council is requested to determine the application in accordance with the legal interpretation of Green Belt policy regarding the extension of residential use into 25% of the spare of the existing storage building. If Wiltshire Council is minded to approve the application then the design of the proposal should be improved by significantly reducing the excessive number and size of rooflights, currently shown as 10. Roof slopes are visible from the canal and elsewhere and the rooflights are intrusive in the landscape and Green Belt context.
