- 2. 1st August SMH for Community Steering Group launch: prioritised list being developed from ideas and will be shared shortly for BOATC actions. Bee talk inspired Girl Guides project and several new venues for beehives in town. Next session of CE Community Steering probable end October details tbc.
- 3. Climate Emergency Motion Letter sent to WCC: There is a Wilts Council community meeting coming up but seems to be little publicity. It'd be good to get a Wiltshire CE page much like the Devon one.
- 4. BoA Drinking Water Fountain Project: 2 out of three now installed; third will be on 16th Sept. Installation has been much more expensive and complicated than anticipated. We will have a celebratory event soon after the third installed end Sept.
- 5. Waste minimisation: Community Fridge location and cost: base in place today. Holly is still on to manage project,
- 6. Waste disposal letter to Wiltshire Council elicited response and WT story. The recycling is to get simpler from next February and WCC are on target for reduction to landfill. Increase in incineration of waste (for power generation). Limited effort to eliminate plastic and other waste.
