3. Social Distancing Scheme

Update on the status of the social distancing scheme.

4. Request to Wiltshire Council's CATG (Community Area Transport Group)

Following the Full Town Council meeting 6th July 2021 and considering the points raised in the debate, Bradford on Avon Town Council recommends that Wiltshire Council's Community Area Transport Group (CATG) be asked to:-

- Consider implementing a permanent 'no entry' at the top of Whitehill and examine mitigation measures for some residences where this might raise access issues;
- Consider design and implementation of a 'no right turn' at the Market Street end of Newtown, subject to the views of residents;
- Agree to add additional advisory signage to support pedestrians wishing to socially distance on town centre pavements, should a decision be taken by Wiltshire Council to remove the social distancing scheme once the legal requirement to distance has been removed.
- Reiterates its commitment to holding a consultation in the autumn on a future scheme to improve pedestrian safety, vehicle flow and air quality, and to reduce traffic volume.
